Idea Fab Labs is creating kits in increments of 20 masks that can be assembled at home with instructions. We anticipate that a mask takes 10-15 minutes to complete depending on your skill. We deliver kits for both 2-layer and a little more involved 4-layer. We can pay people to sew if they need.
