## **FEES EXPLAINED**

There is a registration fee for cases referred in Santa Cruz County of \$50 and many people are eligible to have that fee reduced or eliminated. Fees help offset a small part of the cost of providing this service. Fees can be paid in the office with cash, check or card and online or by phone with a card. The registration fee applies to all cases referred within one year.

There is NO FEE for people referred by these Courts: Iuvenile Court, Behavioral Health Court, or Veterans Court.

Low income families may have fees reduced to \$25 or eliminated based on your household income. The form to request a fee reduction is available on our website or at our office.

## 3. KEEP IN TOUCH

- Turn in timesheets monthly so we make sure you are on track to finish on time.
- Sign up to receive monthly drop-in volunteer options or text reminders.
- Check in with your Case Manager for help as often as you would like.



## 4. GET YOUR CERTIFICATE

- We must verify all timesheets before we can issue your Certificate of Completion.
- We file your Certificate with Probation and the Court online.
- Fees must be paid or waived prior to a Certificate of Completion.
