## **Volunteer Safety Flood Clean Up**

**Please follow these guidelines**

- ❖ **Do not enter a residence without written consent**
  - We will be doing outdoor clean up initially and collecting consent forms from residents to enter their homes
  
- ❖ **Wear a Tyvex Suit and sturdy shoes or rubber boots while volunteering**
  - Tyvex suits will be provided
  
- ❖ **Avoid higher risk situations:**
  - Do Not use ladders, chainsaws or other power tools
  - Do Not use heavy equipment that requires a special license
  - Do Not wade into standing water
  - Do Not go into a house that has a red tag on the front door
  - Do Not go near fallen power lines
  
- ❖ **For general safety:**
  - Always wear a mask to protect yourself from mold when you are indoors
  - When picking up sharp objects do not use your hands, use a shovel.
  - Be aware of slippery surfaces
  - Use teams of 2 or more to move heavy objects that weigh more than 50 pounds
  
- ❖ **Follow instructions from project leaders:**
  - Deposit your trash bag in the designated pick up area and get a new bag before it is too heavy to carry
    - Trash needs to be sorted into the approved categories for collection
  - Communicate with the home owner or representative when possible regarding disposal of any personal items
  - Be sure to wash hands thoroughly with soap and water afterwards
  - Dress appropriately for the weather. Rain gear and/or layers are recommended
  - Work and stay in teams of two or more at all times
  - Inform project leaders if you encounter damaged propane tanks, car batteries, or chemicals

Toilets and Handwashing Only / Solo inodoros y lava manos

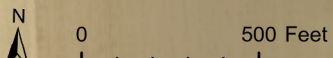
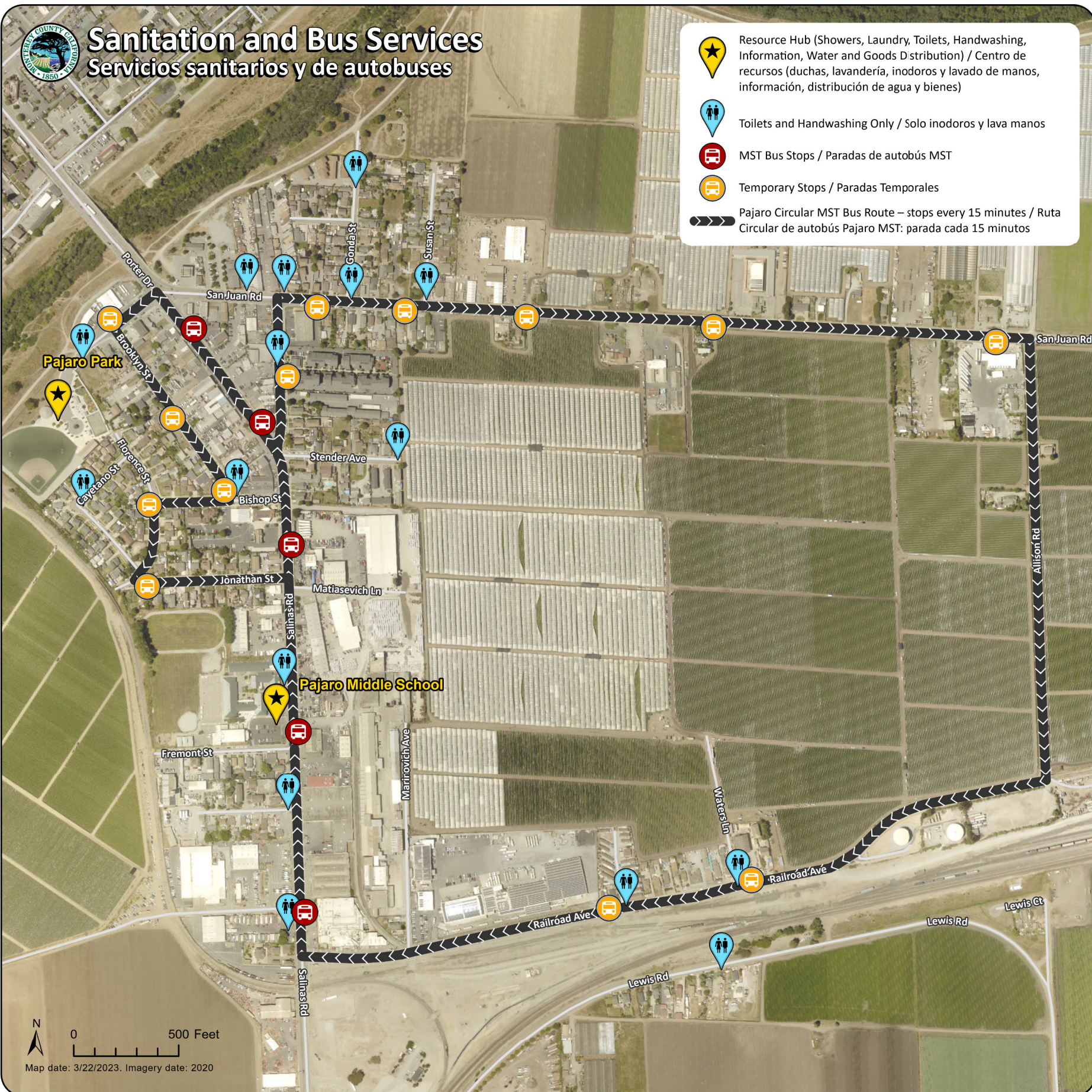


MST Bus Stops / Paradas de autobús MST
