Volunteer Safety Flood Clean Up

Please follow these guidelines

♦ Do not enter a residence without written consent

> We will be doing outdoor clean up initially and collecting consent forms from residents to enter their homes

♦ Wear a Tyvex Suit and sturdy shoes or rubber boots while volunteering

> Tuyvex suits will be provided

Avoid higher risk situations:

- Do Not use ladders, chainsaws or other power tools
- Do Not use heavy equipment that requires a special license
- Do Not wade into standing water
- Do Not go into a house that has a red tag on the front door
- Do Not go near fallen power lines

***** For general safety:


- Always wear a mask to protect yourself from mold when you are indoors
- When picking up sharp objects do not use your hands, use a shovel.
- Be aware of slippery surfaces
- Use teams of 2 or more to move heavy objects that weigh more than 50 pounds

***** Follow instructions from project leaders:

- Deposit your trash bag in the designated pick up area and get a new bag before it is too heavy to carry
 - o Trash needs to be sorted into the approved categories for collection
- Communicate with the home owner or representative when possible regarding disposal of any personal items
- Be sure to wash hands thoroughly with soap and water afterwards
- Dress appropriately for the weather. Rain gear and/or layers are recommended
- Work and stay in teams of two or more at all times
- Inform project leaders if you encounter damaged propane tanks, car batteries, or chemicals

Debris should be placed curbside and not block roadway or access to property.
